Room rates are **\$117.70** per room all taxes included. Up to four guests per room. Each double room is equipped with 2 queen beds. A king bed is in the single rooms. In the event that you will be arriving on September 26 and staying over through September 30th, the rates are the same.

The Hilton Garden Inn amenities include an indoor swimming pool, Jacuzzi and fitness center. The business center is available 24 hours per day as well as a 24hr Pavillion Pantry stocked with snacks, drinks and everything you forgot. Onsite is the Great American Grill and the Pavillion Lounge.
